Training & Technology

Excellent Academic Training

Academic excellence can be achieved through the right perspective of both the student and the teacher. Continuous evaluation of the student is done by the teachers. How to Apply

- * Application from eligible candidate made in the prescribed form only are considered.
- * Candidates must fill the application forms legibly and in their own handwriting.
- * Separate application must be used for each course.
- * The applicants must read the instruction carefully, and make sure that they are eligible to the course they are applying for as per the university requirements.
- * Application forms are issued in the name of the candidates seeking admission and are not transferable.
- * Candidates and their parents are solely responsible for the declaration made in the application form, if at any time, it is found that the particulars given are inaccurate or incomplete students shall forfeit their seat.
- * Completed application can be posted or delivered at the office within 10 days from the date of the publication of the result of the qualify examinations conducted in Tamilnadu. Applicants from other states where the result have not been announced can still send their form filled, except the result column, within the deadline. But they must submit their marks within a reasonable time.
- * The candidates are advised to send their application forms well in advance to avoid any postal delay.
- * Late or incomplete applications, and those giving false information will be summarily rejected.

- * There is no need to affix photograph or enclose copies of mark sheet etc. at the time of applying unless asked for. They must be submitted at the time for scrutiny.

Accompanying documents

- * The candidates must affix sufficient stamps and mention their address on the acknowledgement card if they desire it to be posted.
- * Marks certificate will be verified by the director of the government examinations. If found bogus, admission will be cancelled and also criminal proceeding will be initiated.
- * Selected candidates have to produce three passport size photographs of good quality, mark sheets, transfer and conduct certificates and any other documents that may be required by the college in original at the time of admission. The parent or guardian must accompany the candidates at the time of interview.
- * Applicant passing AISC/CBSE/ISC exam with a minimum of five subjects, including English as compulsory subject need not obtain the prior eligibility certificate from the University of Madras. However, they shall remit the prescribed amount to pay on college office at the time of admission towards recognition fees.
All other candidates in respect of other school in board examination, both Indian and Foreign shall obtain the prior eligibility certificate from the University of Madras.
- * Selected candidates are advised to keep copies of the certificates required, as the originals will be returned only at the end of the course.

Admission Intimation

There is absolutely no need to solicit information about selection. A provisional admission card will be mailed to the selected candidates specifying the time of interview. The receipt of the card by itself does not guarantee admission. Extension of time will not be granted under any circumstances. Rejected applicant will not be intimated, if the candidates admitted into a course abstain from classes for five or more days continuously their name will be removed from the rolls and fees paid will not be refunded. Candidates proficient in sport at a state or national level and other co-curricular activities shall be given preference for admission.

Fees

Generally fees will not be refunded. In special cases, it is the discretion of the institution authorities.
